



Participating in Regional and National Programming

There are two main types of programs: Staple & Signature programs.

Signature Programs: Umbrella and direct impact programs that align us with the mission and directives of the organization (i.e. A Walk for Education, Special Interest Group.)

Staple Programs: Standard yearly provided programs that continue to develop the competency and ability of our members (i.e. Academic Tech Bowl, Try-Math-A-Lon.)

There are hosts of programs for all membership demographics as well as for chapters. Below are the steps to participating in these programs.

1. Become Knowledgeable

There is a wide variety of programs that cover every membership demographic from Alumni, to graduate student and all the way to our NSBE Jr. members and other pre-college sectors. Learn about all of the NSBE programs at www.nsbe.org/programs. Read NSBE emails and magazines to find out about programs that become available throughout the year (i.e. Double Your Membership.) Find out which programs are hosted inside of conferences/conventions and which are not.

2. Register

All registration for regional & national programming occurs on NOL, unless advertisements instruct differently. To register for any event on NOL, click on the “Events” tab on your account homepage and perform a search for your desired program.

3. Participate

Make sure that you are well prepared to give the program your devoted energy. Make sure that you secure travel and lodging for distant location, extended day programs. For programs that take place at conference/conventions, make sure that you register for and attend those events also.
